If you are concerned about cooling, the oil cooler should not be in front of the radiator as that puts more heat into the radiator. Mine is on the right side and gets air from the fog light opening in the bumper and the light well in the valence, with silicon duct material, and some all ducting too, it works great.

If you do not know the provenance of the radiator, I would advise replacing it with a turbo radiator and be done with any heating issues.
