I am looking for a rebuilt manual rack to be used on a 1984 944 whether it is from a 924 or 944. The pinion is shot in mine and need a new one. Anyone have or has a source for a good manual rack.

You can lengthen the lower rod to use the manual or rebuild and clean up the power unit and just go with the power steering and forget the conversion.

There are a few places online that sell rebuilt racks - paragon-products.com is one of them. Pretty pricey, if memory serves. You may be better off checking out A Part Above (see link down the left hand side of the site) or another dismantling company, due to cost - but I'd expect to pay more for the factory manual rack.
