bar.

got the dash painted. sprayed the center strip black, then used that rubber stuff in the tool box drawer to make a CF design across it w/ silver paint, then some tinted clear spray. Then i taped that up and

Last week i welded some tube to the top of the door at the sill- in case i need to climb out w/ the doors closed- also will be used to hold windows up and for pulling the doors closed.
